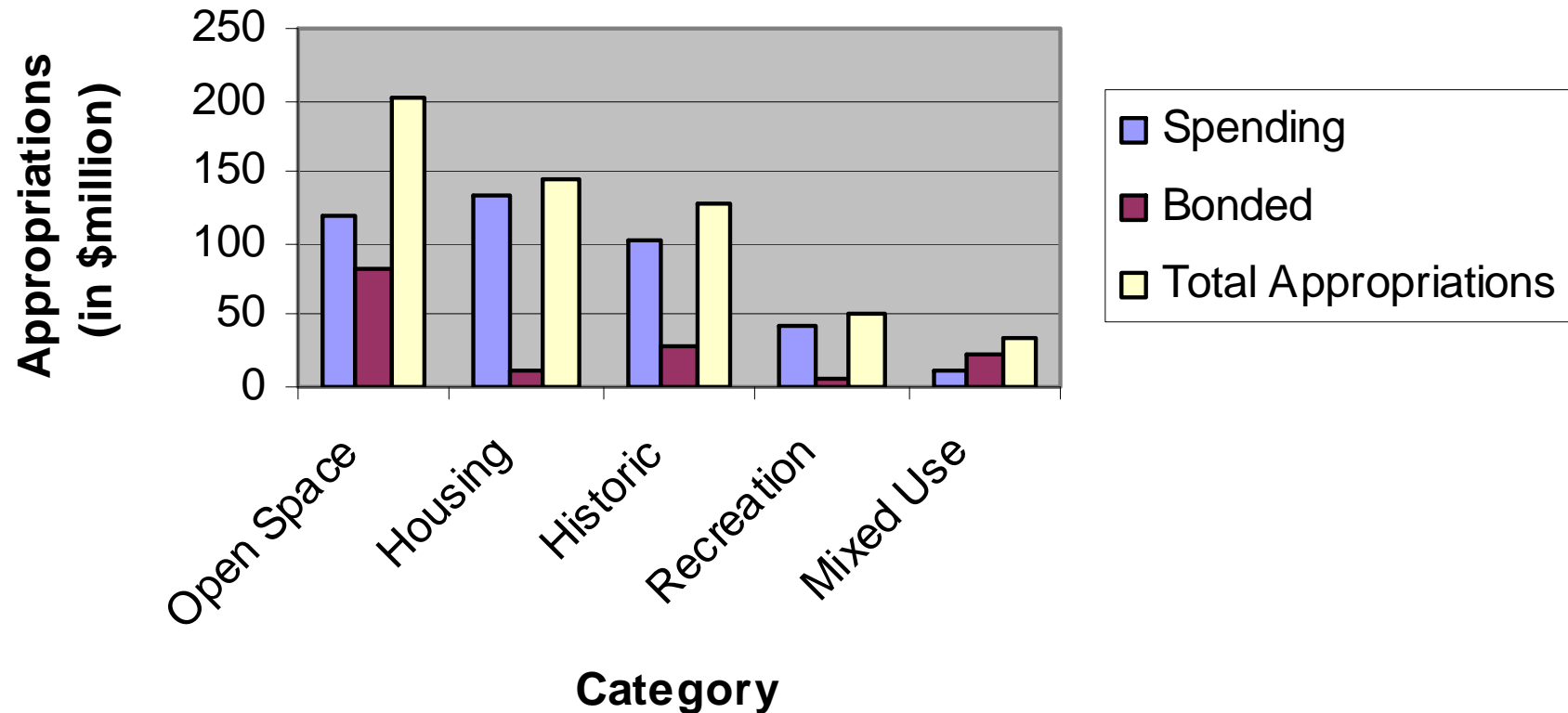

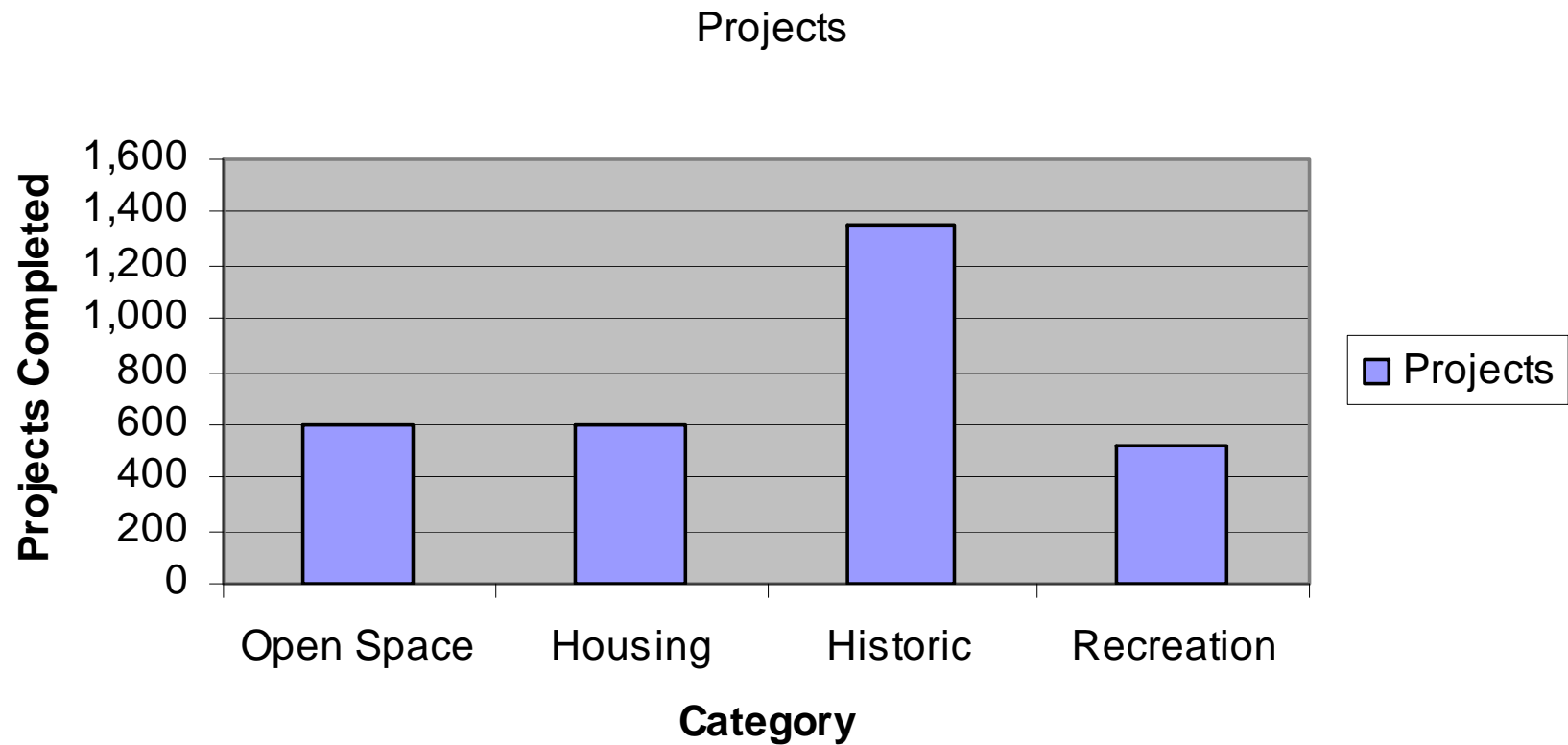

Project Bonding

- 51 different towns
- \$152 million total
- 102 different projects



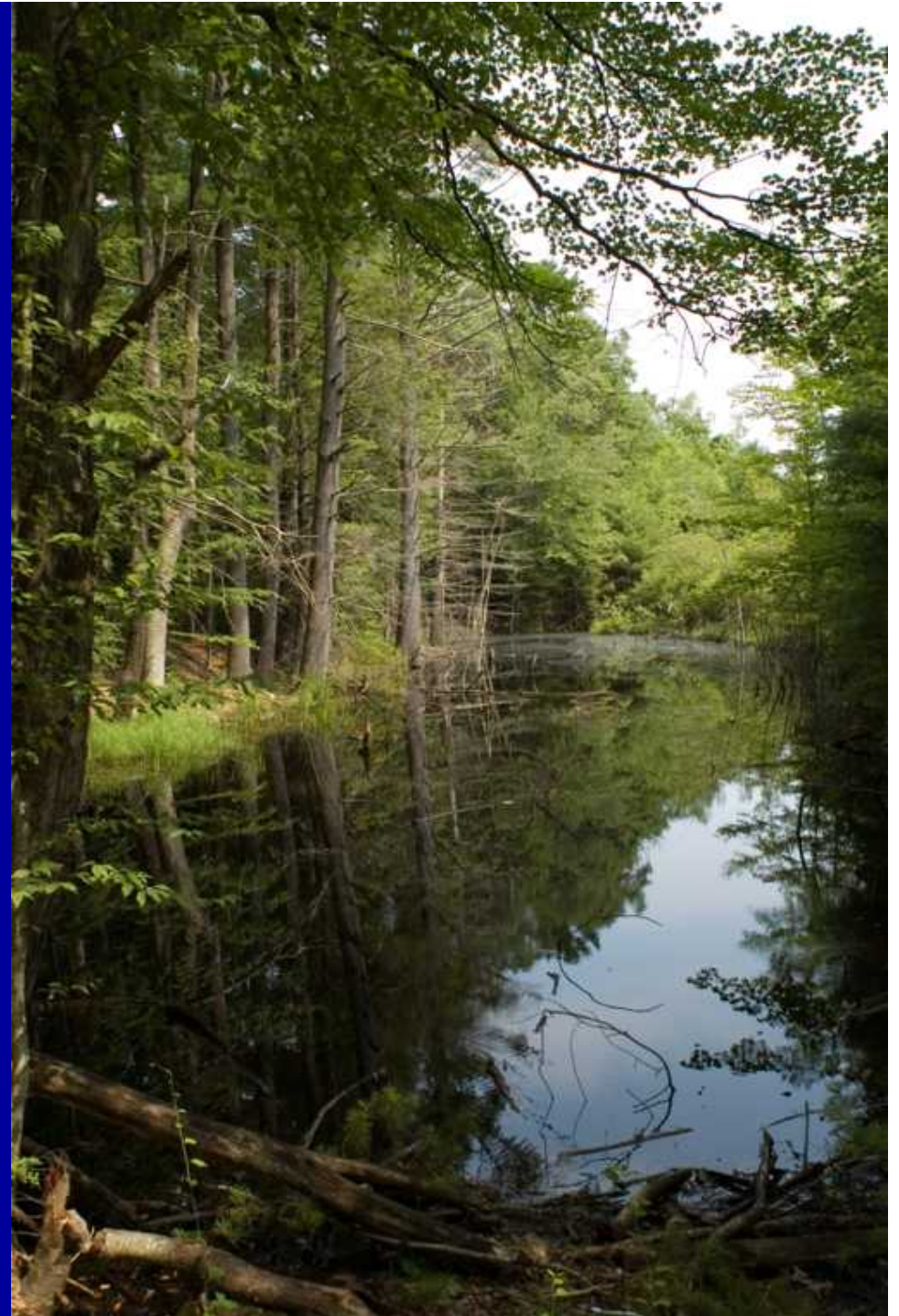
Housing units & totals

- Funding for over 2300 housing units created or rehabilitated.
- Cambridge leads the way with close to 600 units!



Open Space acres & totals

- 10,274 acres protected as open space, with another 971 purchased for CPA uses still to be decided by category.
- Sturbridge leads the way: 1,132 acres
- 25 towns have protected more than 100 acres
