AQUINNAH COMMUNITY PRESERVATION COMMITTEE BYLAW

The Community Preservation Committee shall implement the Community Preservation Act, approved by the Town at the March 14th, 2001 Special Town Meeting. The Committee shall study the needs of the Town regarding Community Preservation (Open Space, Affordable Housing and Historic Preservation), consult with local boards, hold public informational hearings and make recommendations to the Town Meeting for authorized spending under the Act. The committee shall consist of nine (9) members and shall include one member of each of the following organizations: Conservation Commission, Planning Board, Aquinnah Programs Committee, Aquinnah Housing Committee, Board of Selectmen, The Aquinnah Member of the Dukes County Regional Housing Authority, and three (3) At-Large members of the public, named and appointed by the Board of Selectmen. The board, committee, or commission shall be designated by their respective board, committee, or commission, and appointed by the Selectmen. They shall serve for a term of one (1) year.
