Article 22**

Community Preservation Committee

To see if the Town will vote to amend its General Bylaws by adding to Section 20430 the words "Community Preservation Committee" and further by adding a new section as follows:

Section 20560 COMMUNITY PRESERVATION COMMITTEE

- A. There shall be a Community Preservation Committee consisting of nine members. At least one member shall be appointed from the Planning Board, as designated by that Board, one from the Conservation Commission, as designated by that Commission, one from the Housing Authority, as designated by that Authority, one from the Historical Society, as designated by that Society, one from the Recreation Commission, as designated by that Commission, and four from at large, appointed by the Board of Selectmen. All members shall serve for a one year term.
- B. The committee shall be responsible for evaluating the community preservation needs of the Town and making recommendations to town meeting as part of the annual budget process. The committee shall act under the authority of and in accordance with Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 44B Sections 3-7.
- C. This bylaw shall take affect only if MGL Chapter 44B Sections 3-7 are accepted at the regular town election.

Board of Selectmen

VOTED to amend its General Bylaws by adding to Section 20430 the words "Community Preservation Committee" and further by adding a new section as follows:

Section 20560 COMMUNITY PRESERVATION COMMITTEE

- A. There shall be a Community Preservation Committee consisting of nine members.
