Adopting the Community Preservation Act enables Danvers to establish a dedicated funding source for open space, historic preservation, housing and outdoor recreation. **194** other Massachusetts Communities have joined the CPA since 2000, including most of our neighbors in Essex County.

- **CPA funding protects** open space and other natural resources that are important for ecological and recreational reasons. The funds can purchase and preserve land for conservation purposes and improve our parks and sports fields.
- **CPA funding invests** in restoration and preservation of historic sites, vital to maintaining the character of our town. Danvers has a rich history and its many historic treasures, buildings and landmarks are in urgent need of preservation.
- **CPA funding** can maintain housing for Danvers's veteran and seniors. A small individual investment in the CPA will pay large dividends for Danvers.
- **Boost** the local economy, protect home values and enhance the quality of life in Danvers. Preserving open space, maintaining recreation areas and restoring historic sites will continue to make Danvers a welcoming, desirable community we can all be proud of.
- Establish a permanent funding source for Danvers projects, a positive impact that will be appreciated for years to come. The funds generated through a 1% surcharge on property taxes (not assessed value) will be partially matched by the state and deed recordings at the Registry of Deeds ensures a stable and reliable funding source.
